Governor Sununu recently signed into law HB196. This bill established a committee to study requiring passengers on school buses to wear seat belts. This committee will consist of four Representatives and one Senator and will be meeting over the summer and early fall with a deadline of submitting a report by November 1st .

NHSTA has set up a Seatbelt Committee that is already actively engaged in this process. This Annual Meeting will be devoted to a membership discussion on the topic of seat belts in school buses. The committee wants to hear from the membership on their views, concerns, etc. Is there a position that the members would like the NHSTA to take on this topic? Members are encouraged to attend to provide their input on this very important topic.

We will also hold our election of officers for the next fiscal year and award the NHSTA Scholarships for 2017. A review of the year's activities and other committee reports will be presented during the meeting.
