The recipient of the 2024 NHSTA Scholarship must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Must have a parent or guardian who is employed by a member provider company or school district working directly in school bus transportation
- 2. Must be a graduating senior from an accredited high school
- 3. Must attend a post-high school program of study: a college or university, community college, technical school, or professional certificate program
- 4. Must have completed 20 hours of documented community service
- 5. Must complete the application form and provide the required documents:
 - a letter of recommendation from your school (teacher, principal, or guidance counselor)
 - a copy of your most current transcript
 - verification of your community service
 - a short essay describing your goals and future plans
